Θαῦμα Άγίας Εὐφημίας τῆς Μεγαλομάρτυρος

Η ίεφά μνήνη τῆς Άγίας Μεγαλομάφτυφος Εὐφημίας τελεῖται στίς 16 Σεπτεμβρίου, ἐνῶ σήμερα ἑορτάζουμε τό θαῦμα πού ἐπιτέλεσε ἡ Άγία κατά την Δ' Οἰκουμενική Σύνοδο, τό ἔτος 451 μ.Χ., δύο περίπου αἰῶνες μετά τήν κοίμησή της δίδοντας καί πάλι ὁμολογία πίστεως.

Ἡ Δ' Οἰκουμενική Σύνοδος, ἡ ὁποία συγκλήθηκε στή Χαλκηδόνα, ἐπί βασιλέων Μαρκιανοῦ καί Πουλχερίας, καταδίκασε τήν αἵρεση τῶν Μονοφυσιτῶν καί τόν αἱρετικό Εὐτυχῆ, οἱ ὁποῖοι δίδασκαν ὅτι στόν Χριστό, μετά τήν ἕνωση τῶν δύο φύσεων, θείς καί ἀνθρώπινης, ἡ ἀνθρώπινη φύση ἀπορροφήθηκε ἀπό τήν θεία φύση.

Οἱ 630 Ὅσιοι θεοφόροι Πατέρες, πού συγκρότησαν τήν Σύνοδο, ἐδογμάτισαν τήν πίστη τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, ὅτι ὁ Κύριός μας Ἰησοῦς Χριστός ἔχει δύο τέλειες φύσεις, θελήσεις καί ἐνέργειες, τήν θεία καί τήν ἀνθρώπινη, σέ μία ὑπόσταση. Εἶναι δέ ἑνωμένες οἱ δύο φύσεις «ἀτρέπτως, ἀσυγχύτως, ἀναλλοιώτως καί ἀδιαιρέτως».

Κατά τήν Σύνοδο οἱ Ἅγιοι Πατέρες συνέταξαν Τόμο, ὁ ὁποῖος ἀποτύπωνε τήν ὀρθόδοξη πίστη τῆς Ἐκκλησίας. Τό ἴδιο ἔκαναν καί οἱ αἰρετικοί Μονοφυσῖτες πού συνέταξαν τόμο, πού περιεῖχε τίς αἰρετικές δοξασίες καί πλάνες τους. Τότε ὁμόφωνα, γιά νά ἀρθεῖ ἡ διαφωνία, Ὀρθόδοξοι καί αἰρετικοί, τοποθέτησαν τόν τόμο μέ τούς Ὅρους τῆς Συνόδου, καθώς καί τόν τόμο τῶν αἰρετικῶν, στό ἱερό λείψανο τῆς Μεγαλομάρτυρος Εὐφημίας, πού φυλασσόταν τότε ἄφθαρτο στήν Χαλκηδόνα, καί στήν συνέχεια σφράγισαν τήν λάσρνακα καί προσευχήθηκαν. Ὅταν ἄνοιξαν τήν λάρνακα, ἀντίκρυσαν ἕνα πράγματι θαυμαστό θέαμα. Ἡ Ἁγία κρατοῦσε ἐπί τοῦ στήθους αὐτῆς τόν Τόμο τῶν Ὀρθοδόξων, ἐνῶ ὁ τόμος τῶν Μονοφυσιτῶν ἦταν ριγμένος στούς πόδες της.

Έτσι ή Μεγαλομάςτυς Εὐφημία, μέ τό ἐξαίσιο αὐτό θαῦμα, ἐπικύςωσε τόν Τόμο τῶν Πατέςων, πού καλῶς ἐδογμάτισαν, καί διεσάλπισε τό Χςιστολογικό δόγμα πεςί τῶν δύο φύσεων τοῦ Κυρίου καταντροπιάζοντας τούς κακοδόξους.

Εύφράνθητι έπὶ Κύριον, καὶ ἀγαλλιᾶσθε δίκαιοι. Στίχ. Μακάριοι, ὧν ἀφέθησαν αἱ ἀνομίαι.

Τέκνον Τίτε, πιστὸς ὁ λόγος, καὶ περὶ τούτων βούλομαί σε διαβεβαιοῦσθαι, ἵνα φροντίζωσιν καλῶν ἔργων προΐστασθαι οἱ πεπιστευκότες θεῷ. ταῦτά ἐστιν καλὰ καὶ ἀφέλιμα τοῖς ἀνθρώποις μωράς δὲ ζητήσεις καὶ γενεαλογίας καὶ ἔριν καὶ μάχας νομικάς περιΐστασο, είσιν γάρ άνωφελεῖς καὶ μάταιοι. αιρετικὸν ἄνθρωπον μετὰ μίαν καὶ δευτέραν νουθεσίαν παραιτοῦ, είδὼς έξέστραπται ὁ τοιοῦτος καὶ ἁμαρτάνει, ὢν αὐτοκατάκριτος. Όταν πέμψω Άρτεμᾶν πρὸς σὲ η Τυχικόν, σπούδασον έλθεῖν πρός με εἰς Νικόπολιν, ἐκεῖ γὰρ κέκρικα παραχειμάσαι. Ζηνᾶν τὸν νομικὸν καὶ Ἀπολλῶν σπουδαίως μηδὲν πρόπεμψον, ΐνα αὐτοῖς μανθανέτωσαν δὲ καὶ οἱ ἡμέτεροι καλῶν ἔργων προΐστασθαι είς τὰς ἀναγκαίας χρείας, ἵνα μὴ ὦσιν ἄκαρποι. Ἀσπάζονταί σε οἱ μετ 'ἐμοῦ πάντες. Άσπασαι τοὺς φιλοῦντας ἡμᾶς ἐν πίστει. ή χάρις μετὰ πάντων ὑμῶν.

Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous. Verse: Blessed are they whose transgressions have been forgiven.
