Η Μεταμόρφωση του Σωτήρος

Κατά τη διήγηση των Ευαγγελιστών, ο Κύριος μας Ιησούς Χριστός πήρε από τους μαθητές τον Πέτρο (βλέπε 29 Ιουνίου), τον Ιωάννη (βλέπε 26 Σεπτεμβρίου) και τον Ιάκωβο (βλέπε 30 Απριλίου) και ανέβηκε στό όρος Θαβώρ για να προσευχηθεί. Όπως σημειώνει ο Άγιος Νικόδημος ο Αγιορείτης: «Επήρε δε τρεις μόνους Αποστόλους, ως προκρίτους και υπερέχοντας. Ο μεν γαρ Πέτρος επροκρίθη, επειδή ηγάπα πολλά τον Χριστόν. Ο δε Ιωάννης, επειδή ηγαπάτο από τον Χριστόν. Ο δε Ιάκωβος, επειδή εδύνετο να πίη το ποτήριον του θανάτου, το οποίον και ο Κύριος έπιεν».

Οι τσεις μαθητές Του, όπως ήταν κουσασμένοι από τη δύσκολη ανάβαση στο Θαβώς και ενώ κάθισαν να ξεκουσαστούν, έπεσαν σε βαθύ ύπνο. Όταν, ξύπνησαν, αντίκοισαν αποσσδόκητο και εξαίσιο θέαμα. Το πρόσωπο του Κυρίου άστραφτε σαν τον ήλιο, και τα φορέματα Του ήταν λευκά σαν το φως. Τον περιστοίχιζαν δε και συνομιλούσαν μαζί Του δυο άνδρες, ο Μωϋσής (βλέπε 4 Σεπτεμβρίου) και ο Ηλίας (βλέπε 20 Ιουλίου). Γράφει χαρακτηριστικά ο Άγιος Νικόδημος ο Αγιορείτης: «Έφερε δε εις το μέσον τους τον Μωυσήν και τον Ηλίαν, διά να διορθώση τας σφαλεράς υποψίας, οπού είχον οι πολλοί περί αυτού. Καθότι, άλλοι μεν έλεγον τον Κύριον, πως είναι ο Ηλίας. Άλλοι δε, πως είναι ο Ιερεμίας. Διά τούτο λοιπόν επαράστησεν εις το Θαβώς τους πρώτους και κορυφαίους Προφήτας, διά να γνωρίσουν οι μαθηταί, και διά των μαθητών όλοι οι άνθρωποι, πόση διαφορά είναι αναμεταξύ του Χριστού, και των Προφητών. Ο μεν γαρ Χριστός, είναι Δεσπότης. Οι δε Προφήται, είναι δούλοι. Και ίνα μάθουν, ότι ο Κύριος έχει την εξουσίαν του θανάτου και της ζωής. Διά τούτο, από μεν τους αποθαμένους, έφερε τον Μωυσήν. Από δε τους ζωντανούς, έφερε τον Ηλίαν».

Αφού οι μαθητές συνήλθαν κάπως από την έκπληξη, ο πάντα ενθουσιώδης, Πέτρος, θέλοντας να διατηρηθεί αυτή η αγία μέθη που προκαλούσε η ακτινοβολία του Κυρίου, ικετευτικά είπε να στήσουν τρεις σκηνές. Μια για τον Κύριο, μια για το Μωϋσή και μια για τον Ηλία. Πριν προλάβει, όμως, να τελειώσει τη φράση του, ήλθε σύννεφο που τους σκέπασε και μέσα απ' αυτό ακούστηκε φωνή που έλεγε: «Οὖτος ἐστὶν ὁ υἱός μου ὁ ἀγαπητός· αὐτοῦ ἀκούετε» (Λουκά, θ' 28-36). Δηλαδή, Αυτός είναι ο Υιός μου ο αγαπητός, που τον έστειλα για να σωθεί ο κόσμος. Αυτόν να ακούτε.

Οφείλουμε, λοιπόν, και εμείς όχι μόνο να Τον ακούμε, αλλά και να Τον υπακούμε. Σε οποιοδήποτε δρόμο μας φέρει, είμαστε υποχρεωμένοι να πειθαρχούμε.

The Fear of God

Are you afraid of anything? Everybody has something he's at least a little afraid of: maybe snakes, or the dark, or going up on high places. Today, in the Gospel reading, we hear about a different kind of fear. First, we hear how our Lord heals another man who couldn't walk. After Christ healed him, the man stood up and walked home! The Bible says, "When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God." But why were they afraid? Are we supposed to be afraid of God, too? When our priest is ready to give us Holy Communion, he says, "With the fear of God, with faith and love, draw near." Should we be afraid, just like the crowds in the Gospel today were afraid? Well, this time, when we have fear, it's not like when we are afraid of snakes or spiders or sharks. We stay away from those! But when we have fear of God, we show that we are amazed by Him! We show God that we are amazed at what He has done. We are amazed by His power. We are amazed by His love. When we come for Holy Communion, we come with fear. God is so powerful that He could heal the paralyzed man in the story today. God is so powerful, but He is also so loving that He wants us to come closer to Him!

Brethren, having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; if service, in our serving; he who teaches, in his teaching; he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who contributes, in liberality; he who gives aid, with zeal; he who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness. Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with brotherly affection; outdo one another in showing honor. Never flag in zeal, be aglow with the Spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in your hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints, practice hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them.

Καὶ ἰδοὺ αὐτῷ παραλυτικὸν ἐπὶ κλίνης προσέφερον βεβλημένον καὶ ἰδὼν ὁ Ἰησοῦς τὴν πίστιν αὐτῶν εἶπε τῷ παραλυτικῷ θάρσει, τέκνον άφέωνταί σοι αἱ ἁμαρτίαι σου. καὶ ἰδού τινες τῶν γραμματέων εἶπον έαυτοῖς. έν βλασφημεῖ. καὶ ἰδὼν ὁ Ἰησοῦς τὰς ἐνθυμήσεις αὐτῶν εἶπεν ἵνα τί ὑμεῖς ἐνθυμεῖσθε πονηρὰ ἐν ταῖς καρδίαις ὑμῶν; τί γάρ ἐστιν εὐκοπώτερον, εἰπεῖν, ἀφέωνταί σου αἱ άμαρτίαι, ἢ εἰπεῖν, έγειρε καὶ περιπάτει; ἵνα δὲ εἰδῆτε ὅτι ἐξουσίαν ἔχει ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου ἐπὶ τῆς γῆς ἀφιέναι άμαρτίας - τότε λέγει τῷ παραλυτικῷ· ἐγερθεὶς ἄρόν σου τὴν κλίνην καὶ ὕπαγε εἰς τὸν οἶκόν σου. καὶ έγερθεὶς ἀπῆλθεν εἰς τὸν οἶκον αὐτοῦ. ἰδόντες δὲ οἱ ὄχλοι ἐθαύμασαν καὶ έδόξασαν τὸν Θεὸν τὸν δόντα έξουσίαν τοιαύτην τοῖς ἀνθρώποις.

The Gospel According to Matthew 9:1-8

At that time, getting into a boat Jesus crossed over and came to his own city. And behold, they brought to him a paralytic, lying on his bed; and when Jesus saw their faith he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say 'Rise and walk?' But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" he then said to the paralytic -- "Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he rose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.
