

Η ευλάβεια που δείχνει η Εκκλησία στην Παναγία ριζώνει στην υπακοή της στον Θεό, στην εκούσια επιλογή της να δεχθεί μια πρόσκληση αδύνατη στα ανθοώπινα μέτρα. Η Ορθόδοξη Εκκλησία ανέκαθεν τόνιζε τη σύνδεση της Παναγίας με τον άνθρωπο και χαίρεται γι' αυτήν και τη θεωρεί ως τον καλύτερο, καθαρότερο και πιο υπέροχο καρπό της ανθοώπινης ιστορίας και της αναζητήσεως του Θεού από τον άνθοωπο, της αναζητήσεως του έσχατου νοήματος, του έσχατου περιεχομένου της ανθοώπου. ζωής του Αν στη Χριστιανοσύνη η ευλάβεια προς την Παναγία περιστράφηκε γύρω από την αειπαρθενία της, η

καοδιά της ευλάβειας, της σκέψεως και της αγάπης της Ορθόδοξης Ανατολής προς την Παναγία, υπήρξε πάντοτε η Μητρότητά της, η σχέση σαρκός και αίματος που είχε με τον Ιησού Χριστό. Η Ανατολή χαίρεται που ο ρόλος του ανθρώπου είναι βασικός στο θείο σχέδιο. Ο Υιός του Θεού έρχεται στη γη, ο Θεός εμφανίζεται για να λυτρώσει τον κόσμο, γίνεται άνθρωπος για να ενσωματώσει τον άνθρωπο στη θεϊκή του κλήση, και σ' αυτό συμμετέχει ολόκληρη η ανθρωπότητα. Αν αντιληφθούμε πως η κοινή φύση του Χριστού με τη δική μας είναι η μεγαλύτερη χαρά και το μεγαλύτερο βάθος του Χριστιανισμού, ότι ο Χριστός είναι γνήσιος άνθρωπος κι όχι κάποιο φάντασμα ή κάποιο ασώματο φαινόμενο, ότι είναι κάποιος από μας και παραμένει αιωνίως ενωμένος μαζί μας μέσω της ανθρώπινης φύσεώς Του, τότε η ευλάβεια προς την Παναγία γίνεται κατανοητή, επειδή αυτή του προσέφερε την ανθρώπινη φύση, τη σάρκα και το αίμα Του. Αυτή δίνει τη δυνατότητα στον Χριστό να ονομάζεται πάντοτε "Υιός του Ανθρώπου".

For even those who receive circumcision do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may glory in your flesh. But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. Peace and mercy be upon all who walk by this rule, upon the Israel of God. Henceforth let no man trouble me; for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren. Amen.



Well, nowadays we have lots of Christians around us, our friends and our families especially. But after Christ lived on earth, the Christian Church had to grow and grow. Many people were still learning about who Jesus Christ was and what He did for us all! In those years, there were no big huge churches. People gathered together in houses. They prayed together. They celebrated the Holy Eucharist (Communion). They are together and learned about God together. In the Epistle of Saint Paul, he writes about some Christians who didn't worship in a big, huge church. He writes, "Aquila and Prisca, together with the church in their house, send you hearty greetings in the Lord." These two (Aquila and Prisca) were great helpers for Saint Paul. They loved God very much. They were very faithful and they wanted to tell other people about Him! So, they invited Christians to come together to worship in their house. Archeologists have found some of these house churches from almost two thousand years ago!




